



Coronavirus (COVID-19)

To provide the safest environment for our patients and care team, we have implemented the following measures:

- People with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 are not permitted to enter any Ozark facility.
- All patients, visitors, and care team members are required to wear a mask or face covering over their nose and mouth prior to entering any Ozark facility.
- Patients can bring one (1) visitor with them to their appointment.
- All patients will be screened prior to entry into any clinical area.

What are the symptoms of coronavirus?

The Centers for Disease Control reports patients with coronavirus can experience mild to severe respiratory illness with symptoms typically appearing within 2-14 days of being exposed to the virus. Symptoms include:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath

What should I do if I have symptoms?

If you have symptoms stay home and contact your primary care provider for guidance.
